

Weekly bulletin (unofficial translation)

WEEKS 28–29 (6 July – 20 July 2026)

Ongoing Work

- Installation of scaffolding at the building gable ends, followed by the entrance side of the building.
- Balcony protection work.
- Sandblasting. The duration of the sandblasting depends on how firmly the existing coatings are attached. The aim is to complete the sandblasting during Week 29.

Upcoming Work

- Balcony repair work will begin after the sandblasting has been completed.
- Following the sandblasting, the ground-floor corridor will be enclosed with plywood to create a protected pedestrian access tunnel.

Important Information for Residents

- Sandblasting will begin on **Monday, 13 July 2026**. This phase of the project will generate significant noise. During the sandblasting, the building's internal ventilation system will be temporarily switched off. All doors leading to the rear courtyard of the building will be closed and unavailable. This prevents dust from entering the building.
- Please follow all posted access and traffic control signs.
- The garages on the east side of the building will be out of service starting **6 July 2026**. The scaffolding will prevent vehicles from entering or leaving the garages. Pedestrian access to the garages will be maintained whenever possible. The date when the garages will be available for use again will be announced later.
- The housing company's waste containers will be relocated to the area in front of the east wing garages.
- For apartments with fireplaces: The use of fireplaces and chimney exhaust fans is prohibited throughout the renovation. Fireplace dampers must remain closed at all times.
- If you notice any water leaks or dust entering your apartment, please contact the site management immediately.
- The contractor's waste containers are for the contractor's use only.
